



# 2018 IFBLS Young Scientist Award

The Korean Association of Medical Technologists (KAMT) is the sponsor of this Award.

## PURPOSE

The purpose of the IFBLS Young Scientist Award is to encourage IFBLS associate members to present their scientific work and recognize their scientific contribution at the IFBLS World Congress.

## ELIGIBILITY

The presenting and responsible author must be an IFBLS Associate member in good standing. He/She must be a not be over 35 years of age. He/She must be a young scientist undertaking research relevant to Biomedical Laboratory Science profession. He/She must not have won the paper in any competition previously. He/She must be selected by the editor of the symposium of the 33<sup>rd</sup> World Congress IFBLS 2018.

## EVALUATION

- The editor of the symposium of the 33<sup>rd</sup> World Congress IFBLS 2018 will screen the applicants and The IFBLS Awards Committee will select the award winners in consultation with The Korea Association of Medical Technologists (KAMT)
- Finalists will be selected from among the eligible presenters on the basis of the scores allocated in oral presentations.
- Criteria for judging will include: clarity, lecturer's knowledge of the subject, technical design of presentation, content and relevance to the profession.

## APPROVAL OF ABSTRACTS

Abstracts should be selected and acceptance or rejections should be sent to authors before early deadline for registration for the Congress.

## **PRIZE**

The prize consists of \$2,000 USD. One (1) young scientist winner will receive - \$1,000 USD with a medal and two (2) will receive \$500 USD each for their scientific contributions to the successful Congress with their outstanding presentation.

The prize will be awarded by the representative of the Korean Association of Medical Technologists (KAMT) during the Closing Ceremony of the World Congress.
